

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-151

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN  
IMPLEMENTING A RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM  
FOR THE SIERRA COLLEGE PERMIT PARKING AREA

The City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City Council has adopted Ordinance No. 964 which added Chapter 10.26 to the Rocklin Municipal Code creating a Residential Parking permit program and authorizing the City Council to designate certain areas within the City where a Residential Parking Permit program shall be implemented, with such areas designated by Resolution of the City Council.

Section 2. Pursuant to the authority set forth in Chapter 10.26 of the Rocklin Municipal Code, it does hereby establish the Sierra College Permit Parking Area on the following public streets:

- Havenhurst Circle
- Brittany Court
- Foxboro Court
- Birchwood Court
- Wildflower Lane
- Lagoon Court
- Nesting Place
- Blossom Court

Section 3. The Rocklin Police Department shall issue parking permits to residents within this area. "Parking permit" means an official parking permit issued by the Rocklin Police Department. Each residence with a permit parking area shall be issued four (4) parking permits for their use at no charge. The permits shall be valid for a period of two (2) years. Additional permits may be purchased through the Rocklin Police Department at a cost of \$1.00 each. Permits may not be replicated are not transferable to any other individual. When such parking permit is displayed, the vehicle shall be exempt from the time limit otherwise in effect in that area.

Section 4. Designated vehicles in the performance of official duties as specified in Section 10.26.030 of the Rocklin Municipal Code are exempt from the requirements of the permit parking program.
