POLICE AND FIRE



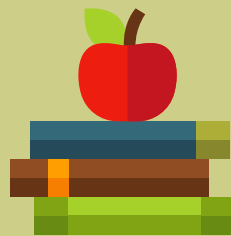

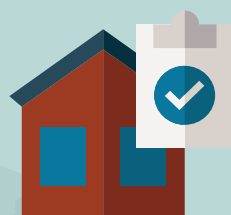
UTILITIES
